### **RADIATION SAFETY ACT 1975**

# RADIATION SAFETY (GENERAL) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (NO. 3) 1994

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

#### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Radiation Safety (General) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 1994.

#### Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1994.

## Principal regulations

- 3. In these regulations the Radiation Safety (General) Regulations 1983\* are referred to as the principal regulations.
