### **BURSWOOD PARK AMENDMENT BY-LAWS 1991**

Made by the Burswood Park Board and approved by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

#### Citation

 These by-laws may be cited as the Burswood Park Amendment By-laws 1991.

## Principal by-laws

- 2. In these by-laws the Burswood Park By-laws 1988\* are referred to as the principal by-laws.

## By-law 30 amended

- 3. By-law 30 of the principal by-laws is amended by deleting "A" and substituting the following —
- " Subject to by-law 30A, a ".

#### By-law 30A inserted

 After by-law 30 of the principal by-laws the following by-law is inserted —

## Dogs shall be restrained at all times

- " 30A. (1) A person may bring a dog onto the reserve, provided that at all times whilst on the reserve, the dog is restrained by the person responsible for the dog by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness of sufficient strength and not exceeding a length of 3 metres.
  - (2) A person who contravenes sub-bylaw (1) commits an offence.

Penalty: \$200.
