STATE SUPPLY COMMISSION ACT 1991**STATE SUPPLY COMMISSION REGULATIONS 1991**

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *State Supply Commission Regulations 1991*.

Public authorities that are totally exempt from section 19 (1)

2. The public authorities listed in Schedule 1 are public authorities which for the purpose of section 20 of the Act are totally exempt from section 19 (1) of the Act.

Partial exemption from section 19 (1)

3. (1) Before granting a partial exemption from section 19 (1) of the Act to a public authority under section 21 of the Act the Commission may request that the public authority submit to the Commission, in writing, a supply management business plan which complies with the relevant provisions of the supply policies regarding such plans.

(2) The Commission may approve of a supply management business plan submitted under subsection (1).

(3) A public authority shall manage the supply of goods and services in accordance with any supply management business plan approved in respect of that public authority.

Review of partial exemptions under section 21

4. (1) Subject to subregulation (2), the Commission shall review an exemption granted to a public authority under section 21 of the Act as provided in the exemption.

(2) The Commission may review an exemption granted to a public authority under section 21 of the Act at any time where the Commission is of the opinion that a review is required.

(3) In reviewing an exemption granted to a public authority under section 21 of the Act the Commission shall consider the effectiveness of any supply management business plan provided to the Commission by the public authority under regulation 3.
