WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MARINE (INFRINGEMENTS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1992

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Western Australian Marine (Infringements) Amendment Regulations 1992.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1992.
