## EXPLOSIVES AND DANGEROUS GOODS ACT 1961

# DANGEROUS GOODS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (NO. 2) 1992

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

#### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1992.

### Principal regulations

- 2. In these regulations the Dangerous Goods Regulations 1992\* are referred to as the principal regulations.

### Schedule amended
