# BARRISTERS' BOARD AMENDMENT RULES (No. 3) 1991

Made by the Barristers' Board under section 6 of the Legal Practitioners Act 1893 and section 25 of the Interpretation Act 1984.

#### Citation

1. These rules may be cited as the Barristers' Board Amendment Rules (No. 3) 1991.

#### Commencement

2. These rules shall come into operation on the day on which the Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 1990 comes into operation.

### Rule 21 amended

- 3. Rule 21 of the Barristers' Board Rules 1949\* is amended-
  - (a) by inserting after subrule (1) the following subrule-
    - " (1a) For the purposes of section 9 (c) of the Act the fee of \$100 is prescribed. "; and
  - (b) in subrule (2) by deleting "sum of \$25.20" and substituting the following—
    - " fee specified in subrule (1a) ".
