HAIRDRESSING ESTABLISHMENT AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1991 Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hairdressing Establishment Amendment Regulations 1991.

Principal regulations

2. In these regulations the Hairdressing Establishment Regulations 1972* are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 3 amended

- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended in the definition of "disinfecting solution"— $\,$
 - (a) by deleting "or" after paragraph (c);

and

- (b) by deleting paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraphs—
 - (d) isopropyl alcohol 70% v/v; or
 - (e) a solution approved as a disinfecting solution by the Executive Director, Public Health, under regulation 3A; ".

Regulation 3A amended

- 4. Regulation 3A of the principal regulations is amended by deleting "or (c)" and substituting the following—
 - ", (c) or (d) ".
