TOBACCO CONTROL ACT 1990

TOBACCO CONTROL (STATEMENT ON VENDING MACHINES) REGULATIONS 1991

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Control (Statement on Vending Machines) Regulations 1991.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 9 August 1991.

Statement on vending machines

3. (1) The statement referred to in section 11 (2) (b) of the Act shall be in the form of 2 notices —

(a) one of which shall consist of a health warning and one of which shall state —

"IT IS AN OFFENCE TO SELL OR SUPPLY CIGARETTES AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS. PENALTY UP TO \$20 000."; and

- (b) each of which shall be displayed in a sign occupying a total area of not less than 210 mm in height and 300 mm in width, and shall be written in letters which —
 - (i) appear in Helvetica Bold Capitals;
 - (ii) are reproduced in white on a black background; and
 - (iii) are not less than 15 mm in height.

(2) In subregulation (1), "health warning" means one of the following warnings —

(a) "SMOKING CAUSES LUNG CANCER

Health Authority Warning";

(b) "SMOKING CAUSES HEART DISEASE

Health Authority Warning";

(c) "SMOKING DAMAGES YOUR LUNGS

Health Authority Warning"; or

(d) "SMOKING REDUCES YOUR FITNESS

Health Authority Warning".
