FISHERIES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (NO. 9) 1991

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Regulations (No. 9) 1991.

Commencement

These regulations shall come into operation on 1 December 1991.
