ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1974

**ROAD TRAFFIC (TOWED AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 1990**

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Towed Agricultural Implements) Amendment Regulations 1990*.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on the day on which they are published in the *Government Gazette*.

Regulation 31 added

3. After Regulation 30 of the *Road Traffic (Towed Agricultural Implements) Regulations 1990** the following regulation is added—

Transitional

- "31. (1) Notwithstanding anything in these regulations, a person who moves a towed implement that conforms with the Towed Agricultural Implements Directions in a manner that complies with those directions is deemed to comply with these regulations.
- (2) For the purposes of this regulation a reference in the Towed Agricultural Implements Directions to the Chief Executive Officer shall be read and construed as a reference to the Traffic Board.
- (3) In this regulation—
- "Towed Agricultural Implements Directions" means the directions given under the *Vehicle Standards Regulations 1977* published in the *Government Gazette* 20 June 1980 pages 1806-1807.
- (4) This regulation ceases to have effect on and from 1 March 1991. "
