Criminal Procedure Act 2004

Criminal Procedure Amendment Regulations 2018

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Criminal Procedure Amendment Regulations 2018*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Criminal Procedure Regulations 2005*.

4. Regulation 13AA inserted

After regulation 13 insert:

13AA. Applications under *Bail Act 1982* section 54

- (1) A person wanting to make an application under the *Bail Act 1982* section 54(2)(b) must make the application by lodging a Form 5A.
- (2) The application may, but does not have to be, supported by an affidavit.

5. Regulation 14 amended

(1) In regulation 14(1) delete "an application" and insert:

an application, other than an application under the *Bail Act 1982* section 54(2)(b),

- (2) Delete regulation 14(2) and insert:
 - (2) A person wanting to make the application must make the application by lodging a Form 6.
- (3) Delete regulation 14(4) and (5).

6. Regulation 14A inserted

After regulation 14 insert:

14A. Procedure for applications under Subdivision

- (1) An application under this Subdivision must be served on each party in accordance with the CPA Schedule 2 clause 2 or 3.
- (2) The application must be heard in court and not in chambers.

In regulation 15 delete "regulation" and insert:
