Industrial Hemp Amendment Act 2018

An Act to —

- **amend the *Industrial Hemp Act 2004* to increase the permitted level of tetrahydrocannabinol in industrial hemp to no more than 1%; and**
- **consequentially amend the *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981*.**

[Assented to 28 August 2018]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Short title

This is the *Industrial Hemp Amendment Act 2018*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows —

- (a) Part 1 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act — on a day fixed by proclamation, and different days may be fixed for different provisions.
