REGISTRATION OF IDENTITY OF PERSONS ACT 1975

Registration of Identity of Persons Regulations 1975

Chief Secretary's Department, Perth, 7th April, 1976.

His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council acting under the provisions of the *Registration of Identity of Persons Act 1975* and under the provisions of section 11 of the *Interpretation Act 1918*, has been pleased to make the regulations set forth in the Schedule below to take effect on and from the day that the *Registration of Identity of Persons Act 1975* comes into operation.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Registration of Identity of Persons Regulations 1975*.

2. Interpretation

In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears —

"Form" means a form in the Second Schedule;

"Schedule" means a schedule to these regulations;

"section" means a section of the Act;

"the Act" means the Registration of Identity of Persons Act 1975.

3. Application for entry of identity (Form 1) (Form 2)

An application to the Registrar General for the entry of a person's identity in the Register pursuant to subsection (3) of section 4 shall —

- (a) in the case of a person who has attained the age of eighteen years, be in the form of Form 1; and
- (b) in the case of a person who has not attained the age of eighteen years, be in the form of Form 2.

4. Application for entry of change of name (Form 3)

An application to the Registrar General for the entry of a change of name in the Register pursuant to subsection (1) of section 11 shall be in the form of Form 3.

5. Index of names of persons registered

The names of the persons whose identities are entered in the Register shall be indexed in any index of names made for the purposes of the *Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Act 1961*.

6. Fees

The fees prescribed in the First Schedule are payable in respect of the several matters set forth in that Schedule.
