## Heritage of Western Australia Regulations 1991

### 1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Heritage of Western* Australia Regulations 1991<sup>1</sup>.

### 2. Commencement

These regulations shall come into operation on 11 February 1991.

## 3A. Works, acts or things excluded from definition of *development*

- (1) For the purpose of the definition of *development* in section 3(1) of the Act, the following works, acts or things are excluded from the operation of that definition
  - (a) building maintenance that does not involve the removal of, or damage to, the existing fabric of the building or the use of new materials;
  - (b) cleaning that is low pressure, non-abrasive and non-chemical;
  - (c) gardening or landscape maintenance that does not involve a major alteration of the layout, contours, structures, significant plant species or other significant features on the land;
  - (d) repairs, including replacing missing or deteriorated fabric with like for like fabric, that does not involve the

### **3.** Form of Register prescribed — section 46(1)

- (a) the Register shall be made up of all entries made by the Council, both interim and permanent, under Part 5 of the Act; and
- (b) the form in Schedule 1 is prescribed.
