## **Appropriation (Capital 2022-23) Act 2022**

**No. 22 of 2022**

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2023.**

*[Assented to 16 August 2022]*

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

---

**1. Short title**

This is the *Appropriation (Capital 2022-23) Act 2022*.

**2. Commencement**

This Act comes into operation as follows —

- (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

**3. Issue and application of moneys**

- (1) The sum of \$5 170 419 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year beginning on 1 July 2022 and ending on 30 June 2023.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Recurrent 2022-23) Act 2022*.

**4. Appropriation for capital purposes**

The sum of \$5 170 419 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
