#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2023.* 

#### 2. Commencement

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published on the WA legislation website;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

#### **3.** Regulations amended

These regulations amend the Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Regulations 1982.

#### 4. Regulation 68 amended

- (1) In regulation 68(1) delete the definition of *firefighting employment*.
- (2) In regulation 68(1) insert in alphabetical order:
