### Part 1 — Preliminary

#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Environment Regulations Amendment* (Aboriginal Heritage) Regulations 2023.

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) Part 1 on the day on which these regulations are published on the WA legislation website;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day on which the *Aboriginal Heritage Legislation Amendment and Repeal Act 2023* section 3 comes into operation.

This Part amends the *Conservation and Land Management Regulations* 2002.

#### 4. Regulation 2 amended

(1) In regulation 2 delete the definitions of:

Aboriginal object

Aboriginal place

(2) In regulation 2 insert in alphabetical order:

Aboriginal artefact means an object to which the Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972 applies;

Aboriginal site means a place to which the Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972 applies;

#### 5. Regulation 37 amended

In regulation 37(2) delete "Aboriginal place or Aboriginal object," and insert:

Aboriginal site or Aboriginal artefact,
