## Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 2000

No. 32 of 2000

An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the capital services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 2001.

[Assented to 6 July 2000]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

#### 1. **Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 2000.

#### 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### 3. Issue and application of moneys

- (1) The sum of \$569 317 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 1)* 2000.

#### 4. Appropriation of Purpose

The sum of \$569 317 000 granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the capital services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
