# **Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 2001**

**No. 41 of 2001**

---

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2002.**

*[Assented to 7 January 2002]*

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 2001*.

**2. Commencement**

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**3. Issue and application of moneys**

- (1) The sum of \$222 282 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 2001 to 30 June 2002.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Supply Act 2001* and the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 1) 2001*.

**4. Appropriation for capital purposes**

The sum of \$622 282 000 comprising —

- (a) the sum granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty;  
and
- (b) \$400 000 000 of the sum granted by the *Supply Act 2001* as supply to Her Majesty,

is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
