2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Issue and application of moneys

- (1) The sum of \$1 212 340 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act* (*No. 1) 2005.*

4. Appropriation for capital purposes

The sum of \$1 212 340 000 granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
