Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Parliamentary Privileges) Amendment Act 2004.*

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

- (a) the privileges, immunities and powers set out in this Act; and
- (b) to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this Act, the privileges, immunities and powers by custom, statute or otherwise of the
