An Act to amend the Human Tissue and Transplant Act 1982.

[Assented to 11 May 2006]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

page 1 As at 11 May 2006 No. 14 of 2006

1. **Short title**

This is the *Human Tissue and Transplant Amendment Act* 2006.

Commencement 2.

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Act amended

The amendment in this Act is to the *Human Tissue and* Transplant Act 1982*.

4. Section 29 amended

After section 29(4) the following subsections are inserted —

- - Where the Minister considers it desirable by reason of (4a) special circumstances so to do, the Minister may, in writing, approve the entering into of a contract or arrangement that would, but for the approval, be void under subsection (1), and nothing in subsection (1) or (2) applies to or in relation to a contract or arrangement entered into in accordance with an approval under this subsection.
- The Minister must not give an approval under (4b) subsection (4a) unless
 - the entering into of the contract or arrangement has been recommended by a body of medical practitioners prescribed by the regulations for the purposes of this subsection; and

(b) the Minister is reasonably satisfied that no monetary payment or reward will be made, given or received for or in consideration of the contract or arrangement.
