Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 2006

No. 40 of 2006

An Act to amend the *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981*.

[Assented to 22 September 2006]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This is the *Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 2006*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on a day fixed by proclamation.

3. The Act amended

The amendments in this Act are to the *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981**.

4. Section 32A amended

Section 32A(3) is amended in the definition of “external serious drug offence” as follows:

- (a) in paragraph (a) after “law of” by inserting —
“ the Commonwealth, of ”;
- (b) by deleting paragraph (b) and inserting instead —
“
 - (b) offence against —
 - (i) the repealed section 233B of the *Customs Act 1901* of the Commonwealth; or
 - (ii) a law of the Commonwealth, which offence is prescribed to correspond to an offence against that repealed section;”.
