s. 1

1. Short title

This is the Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Act (No. 2) 2007.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows:

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act on the day after that day.

3. Issue and application of moneys

- (1) The sum of \$2 799 110 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year from 1 July 2007 to 30 June 2008.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Act* (*No. 1*) 2007.

4. Appropriation for capital purposes

The sum of \$2 799 110 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
