## **Swan and Canning Rivers (Transitional)** Regulations (No. 2) 2007

#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the Swan and Canning Rivers (Transitional) Regulations (No. 2) 2007.

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows:

- regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the Gazette;
- the rest of the regulations on the day after that day. (b)

#### **3.** Leased parts of the River reserve

If the Minister and the Minister to whom the administration of the Marine and Harbours Act 1981 is committed so approve, in respect of a lease referred to in the Swan and Canning Rivers (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Act 2006 section 13 —

- (a) the department responsible for administering the Marine and Harbours Act 1981 may manage the lease as an agent of the Trust; and
- with the approval of the Treasurer, revenue derived from (b) the lease may be credited to an agency special purpose
