Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act (Search Warrant) Regulations 1979

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act (Search Warrant) Regulations* 1979 ¹.

2. Form of Warrant

For the purposes of section 53 of the *Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act 1961*, a search warrant shall be in the following form —

To wit) To WHEREAS it appears to me a Justice of the Peace by the information on oath of (A.B.) of in the State of Western Australia (occupation) that there is reasonable ground for suspecting that a breach of the *Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act 1961*, as amended, or of regulations made under that Act, has been or is being committed, or that preparation has been made to commit such a breach, within a dwelling-house, to wit,

This is therefore to authorise and request you together with a police constable at any time or times within 14 days from the date of this warrant to enter, if need be by force, the said dwelling-house, and to search that
