BOOKMAKERS BETTING LEVY AMENDMENT ACT 1998

No. 28 of 1998

AN ACT to amend the Bookmakers Betting Levy Act 1954.

[Assented to 30 June 1998.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bookmakers Betting Levy Amendment Act 1998*.

Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section 2 repealed and a section substituted

3. Section 2 of the *Bookmakers Betting Levy Act* 1954* is repealed and the following section is substituted —

Bookmakers' betting levy

- **2.** (1) The rate of bookmakers' betting levy imposed by this Act and payable under the Betting Control Act 1954 is
 - (a) in respect of a bookmaker's turnover from betting on a sporting event or contingency approved under section 4B of the *Betting Control Act 1954*, the rate of 0.5%; and
 - (b) in respect of the remainder of a bookmaker's turnover, the rate of 2%.
 - (2) In this section
 - **"turnover"** has the meaning given in section 14 (1) of the *Betting Control Act 1954*.
