**APPROPRIATION
(CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT
(No. 2) 1996**

No. 19 of 1996

AN ACT to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 1997.

[Assented to 28 June 1996.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 1996*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Issue and application of moneys

3. (1) The sum of \$465 364 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 1996 to 30 June 1997.

(2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 1) 1996*.

Appropriation of Purpose

4. The sum of \$465 364 000 granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the capital services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Estimates for the year.
