## APPROPRIATION (CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT (No. 1) 1995

No. 65 of 1995

AN ACT to grant further supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 1996.

[Assented to 27 December 1995.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 1) 1995.

#### Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### Issue and application of moneys

- 3. (1) The sum of \$1 656 846 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 1995 to 30 June 1996.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the Supply Act 1995.

#### **Appropriation of Purpose**

- 4. The sum of \$4 656 846 000 comprising
  - (a) the sum granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty; and
  - (b) \$3 000 000 000 of the sum granted by the Supply Act 1995 as supply to Her Majesty,

is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Estimates for the year.
