**ROAD TRAFFIC AMENDMENT
(POWER ASSISTED PEDAL
CYCLES) ACT 1991**

No. 50 of 1991

AN ACT to amend the *Road Traffic Act 1974*.

[Assented to 17 December 1991]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Road Traffic Amendment (Power Assisted Pedal Cycles) Act 1991*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on such day as is fixed by proclamation.

Section 5 amended

3. Section 5 of the *Road Traffic Act 1974** is amended —

- (a) in the definition of “moped” by inserting after “pedal cycle” the following —

“ , but does not include a power assisted pedal cycle ”;

- (b) in the definition of “motor vehicle” by inserting after “to a motor vehicle” the following —

“ , but does not include a power assisted pedal cycle ”;

and

- (c) by inserting after the definition of “permit” the following definition —

“ “**power assisted pedal cycle**” means a vehicle designed to be propelled through a mechanism operated solely by human power, to which is attached one or more auxiliary propulsion motors having a combined maximum output not exceeding 200 watts; ”.
