CEMETERIES.

AN ACT to amend the Cemeteries Act 1897-1978.

[Assented to 5 November 1980.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Cemeteries $\frac{1}{1000}$ Short title Amendment Act 1980.

(2) In this Act the Cemeteries Act 1897-1978 is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act $\frac{94 \text{ of } 1972}{\text{ and } 3 \text{ of } 1978}$. may be cited as the Cemeteries Act 1897-1980. Commencement. 2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section this Act shall come into operation on the day it is assented to by the Governor.

(2) Section 5 of this Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Section 12 amended. 3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by inserting after "administration of the cemetery" the following—

" and such other buildings as are necessary for the purposes of the cemetery or the use and convenience of persons visiting it or both ".

Section 16A amended. 4. Section 16A of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph—

" (ba) let or lease any building provided by the trustees for the use and convenience of persons visiting the cemetery; ".

Section 30 amended. 5. Section 30 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by deleting the passage "or, if the trustee of the cemetery is the council of a municipality, by an inspector of the Government Department known as the Department of Local Government".
