

CONSTITUTION (No. 3).

No. 15 of 1980.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Act 1889-1979.

[Assented to 15 October 1980.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Amendment Act (No. 3) 1980*.

(2) In this Act the Constitution Act 1889-1979 is referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section 22 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted—

Oath or
affirmation
of allegiance.

“ 22. No member of the Legislative Council or Legislative Assembly shall sit or vote therein until he has taken and subscribed before the Governor, or some person authorised by the Governor in that behalf, an oath or affirmation of allegiance in the form set out in Schedule E to this Act. ” .

3. The principal Act is amended by adding, at the end, the following Schedule—

“ SCHEDULE E. Section 22.

OATH

I, _____, do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, according to law.

So help me God.

AFFIRMATION

I, _____, do solemnly and sincerely affirm and declare that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, according to law.

(Note:—The name of the reigning Sovereign for the time being is to be substituted from time to time). ” .
