AN ACT to amend sections 37 and 43 of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899-1978.

[Assented to 9 September 1980.]

RE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Short title and citation. Amendment Act 1980.

- (2) In this Act the Constitution Acts Amendment Approved for reprint 1899-1978 is referred to as the principal Act.

 Approved for reprint 18th May, Act 1899-1978 is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899-1980.
