CONVICTED INEBRIATES' REHABILITATION REPEAL ACT

No. 14 of 1989

AN ACT to repeal the *Convicted Inebriates' Rehabilitation Act 1963* and to amend the *Acts Amendment (Mental Health) Act 1981*.

[Assented to 16 November 1989]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Convicted Inebriates' Rehabilitation Repeal Act 1989*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Repeal

3. The *Convicted Inebriates' Rehabilitation Act 1963** is repealed.

Amending Act

4. In this Act the *Acts Amendment (Mental Health) Act 1981** is referred to as the amending Act.

Long title amended

5. The long title of the amending Act is amended by deleting "the *Convicted Inebriates' Rehabilitation Act 1963-1974*,".

Part II repealed

6. Part II of the amending Act is repealed.
