ACTS AMENDMENT (FINANCIAL PROVISIONS OF REGULATORY BODIES) ACT

No. 77 of 1987

AN ACT to amend certain Acts relating to professional and trade regulatory bodies to impose appropriate and consistent accounting, reporting and audit requirements.

[Assented to 26 November 1987]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Acts Amendment (Financial provisions of regulatory bodies) Act 1987.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on 1 January 1988.

Amendment of Acts

3. The Acts referred to in the first column of Schedule 1 are amended to the extent to which and in the manner in which they are in the second column of that schedule expressed to be amended.

Savings and transitional

4. The amendments contained in this Act shall not apply in respect of a financial year of a board or authority that has ended, or has commenced but has not ended, before this Act comes into operation and any Act amended by this Act shall continue to apply in respect of such a financial year as if it had not been amended.
