

CONSTITUTION.

No. 8 of 1983.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899-1981.

[Assented to 29 September 1983.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Amendment Act 1983*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899-1981 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved 18 May 1971. Amended by Acts Nos. 9 of 1972, 52 of 1973, 30 of 1974, 15, 71, 86 and 111 of 1975, 28 of 1977, 59 of 1978, 4 and 5 of 1980, and 13 of 1981.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899-1983.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
