

LOTTERIES (CONTROL).

No. 29 of 1983.

AN ACT to amend the Lotteries (Control) Act 1954-1982.

[Assented to 1 December 1983.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Lotteries (Control) Amendment Act 1983*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Lotteries (Control) Act 1954-1982 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved 19 April 1979 and amended by Acts Nos. 103 of 1981 and 24 and 72 of 1982.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act 1954-1983.

2. After section 10B of the principal Act, the following section is inserted—

Restriction
on sales of
instant
lottery
tickets.

“ 10C. A person shall not—

(a) sell a ticket in an instant lottery;

or

(b) cause or permit a ticket in an instant lottery to be sold,

to a person who has not attained the age of 16 years.

Penalty: \$200. ”.
