AN ACT to amend the Education Act, 1928-1975.

[Assented to 3rd June, 1976.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Education $\frac{3}{2}$ Act Amendment Act, 1976.

(2) In this Act the Education Act, 1928-1975 is Reprinted as approved for referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Education Act, 1928-1976.

Short title and citation. Section 36A added.

Special provision for superannuation and like benefits in respect of employees formerly employed by W.A. Pre-School Board. 2. The principal Act is amended by adding after section 36 the following new section—

36A. The Minister, with the approval of the Treasurer of the State, may, on behalf of any teacher who, immediately before he became a teacher, was—

- (a) an employee of the Western Australian Pre-School Board; and
- (b) a contributor to a scheme maintained by that Board for the purposes of making financial provision in respect of the retirement, invalidity or death of employees of that Board,

participate in that scheme and make contributions under the scheme in respect of any such teacher, but nothing in this section shall authorise the Minister to continue to make any contributions to that scheme on behalf of a teacher who becomes a contributor for the purposes of the Superannuation and Family Benefits Act, 1938.
