AN ACT to amend section one hundred and ninetyseven and section two hundred and forty-three, and to repeal section two hundred and seven, of the Local Government Act, 1960-1975.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

(1) This Act may be cited as the Local short title and citation. Government Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1976.

(2) In this Act the Local Government Act, 1960-1975, is referred to as the principal Act.
