CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT.

No. 15 of 1975.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act. 1899-1974.

[Assented to 9th May, 1975.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Short title and citation. Acts Amendment Act, 1975.

(2) In this Act the Constitution Acts International Act. for reprint 18th May, 1971, and amended by Acts 1899-1974, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act ⁹ of 1972. may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment and 30 of 1974. Act, 1899-1975.

Section 38 amended. 2. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the words "this Act" appearing at the end of the first proviso to the section, the words "or if that office be that of Parliamentary Secretary of the Cabinet".
