ACTS AMENDMENT (ROAD TRAFFIC).

No. 58 of 1974.

AN ACT to amend The Criminal Code, the Coroners Act, 1920-1960, the Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 1973, the Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Act, 1963-1973 and the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Act, 1943-1973.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Acts Amendment short utile. (Road Traffic) Act, 1974.

2. The provisions of this Act shall come into commenceoperation on such date or such dates as is or are, respectively, fixed by proclamation.

PART I.—THE CRIMINAL CODE.

Interpretation of "the Code". 3. In this Part of this Act "the Code" means The Criminal Code set out in the Schedule to the Criminal Code Act, 1913, set out in Appendix B to the Criminal Code Act Compilation Act, 1913, as reprinted, with amendments to and including Act No. 1 of 1969 incorporated, pursuant to the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938 and further amended by Acts Nos. 21 and 41 of 1972 and 19 of 1973.

Section 277 amended. 4. Section 277 of the Code is amended by substituting for the passage "manslaughter, or causing death by the negligent use or management of a vehicle", the words "or manslaughter".

Section 291A repealed. 5. Section 291A of the Code is repealed.

Section 595 amended. 6. Section 595 of the Code is amended by substituting for the passage "a crime under section two hundred and ninety-one A hereof, if that crime" in lines three and four of the last proviso to that section, and substituting the passage "an offence under section fifty-nine of the Road Traffic Act, 1974, if that offence".

Charge of grievous bodily harm. 7. Chapter LXIII of the Code is amended by adding after section 595 a section as follows—

595A. Upon an indictment charging a person with the crime of doing grievous bodily harm to another, he may be convicted of an offence under section fifty-nine of the Road Traffic Act, 1974, if that offence is established by the evidence.
