CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT.

No. 30 of 1974.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act. 1899-1973.

[Reserved 1st November, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Short title and citation. 1. Acts Amendment Act, 1974.

 (2) In this Act the Constitution Acts Amendment et, 1899-1973, is referred to as the principal Act.
(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may Act, 1899-1973, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act. 1899-1974.
