AN ACT to amend the Official Prosecutions (Defendants' Costs) Act, 1973.

[Assented to 19th September, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Official Short title Prosecutions (Defendants' Costs) Act Amendment and Act, 1974.
- (2) In this Act the Official Prosecutions Act No. 46 (Defendants' Costs) Act, 1973 is referred to as the principal Act.

- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Official Prosecutions (Defendants' Costs) Act, 1973-1974.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

Section 6 amended.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for paragraph (a) a paragraph as follows—

(a) the Court—

- (i) under section 669 of The Criminal Code, section 26, 34, or 34B of the Child Welfare Act, 1947, or section 137 of the Police Act, 1892 dismisses the charge against him; or
- (ii) under subsection (1a) of section 16, or subsection (3) of section 17A, of the Education Act, 1928 refrains from recording a conviction against him;
