SUPREME COURT.

No. 56 of 1974.

AN ACT to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1971.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Supreme Short title Court Act Amendment Act, 1974.
- (2) In this Act the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1971 is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1974.

Commencement, 2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

Section 30 amended.

3. Section 30 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the passage "subject to the provisions of section seventeen of this Act, and", in lines two and three.

Section 130 repealed and re-enacted.

4. Section 130 of the principal Act is repealed and re-enacted as follows—

Enforcement of judgment or order for possession.

130. A judgment or order for possession of land, and the payment of any money adjudged or ordered to be paid by the judgment or order, may be enforced in such manner as the Rules of Court prescribe. .

Section 167 amended.

- 5. Subsection (1) of section 167 of the principal Act is amended by adding after paragraph (m) a paragraph as follows—
 - (n) For prescribing the manner in which a judgment or order for possession of land, and the payment of any money adjudged or ordered to be paid by the judgment or order, may be enforced.
