JUDGES' SALARIES AND PENSIONS.

No. 13 of 1973.

AN ACT to amend the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1972.

[Assented to 25th May, 1973.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1973.

(2) In this Act the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1972, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1973.

Section 2 amended. 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the interpretation "Judge" the following interpretation—

"Prior judicial service", in relation to a person who is a Judge or retired Judge, means service as a judge of a court of another State or Territory of the Commonwealth (not being service as a Justice of the Peace or Magistrate) being service prior to the appointment of that person as a Judge; .

Section 6 amended. 3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by adding after subsection (2) the following subsection—

(2a) For the purposes of this Act, where a Judge had prior judicial service, the period of that service shall be added to, and be deemed to form part of, his period of service as a Judge.
