AN ACT to amend the Mining Act, 1904-1971.

[Assented to 15th May, 1973.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Mining Act Amendment Act, 1973*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Mining Act, 1904-1971, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved for reprint 20th January, 1969 and amended by Acts Nos. 53 of 1968, 17 of 1969, 33 of 1970, 2 of 1971 and 56 of 1971.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Mining Act, 1904-1973.
