AN ACT to amend the Government Railways Act, 1904-1970.

[Assented to 1st December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

(1) This Act may be cited as the Government Short title Railways Act Amendment Act, 1971.

- (2) In this Act the Government Railways Act, Vol. 17 of the Reprinted 1904-1970 is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Government Railways Act, 1904-1971.
