AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section fortyfour of the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1968.

[Assented to 13th September, 1971.]

RE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Industrial* and citation. Arbitration Act Amendment Act, 1971.

- (2) In this Act the Industrial Arbitration Act, Reprinted Acts. 1912-1968, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Industrial Arbitration Act. 1912-1971.

Approved for reprint 23rd May, Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment to s. 44. (Constitution of Commission.) 3. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 44 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "three" the word "four".
