MARKETING OF LINSEED.

No. 65 of 1971.

AN ACT to amend the Marketing of Linseed Act, 1969 to provide for the marketing of other seeds and for purposes incidental thereto.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Marketing Short title of Linseed Act Amendment Act, 1971.
- (2) In this Act the Marketing of Linseed Act, 1969 is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Seed Marketing Act, 1969-1971.

Amendment to long title.

- 2. The long title to the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by substituting for the word "Linseed", in line two, the word "Seed"; and
 - (b) by adding after the word "linseed", in line three, the passage ", rapeseed, and any other seed that is declared to be a seed for the purposes of this Act,".

Addition of

3. The principal Act is amended by adding after section 2 a section as follows—

Change of name of Board,

- 2A. (1) On and after the coming into operation of this section the Board established by this Act and known as the Western Australian Linseed Board is preserved and continues in existence as a body corporate under and subject to the provisions of this Act by the name "Western Australian Seed Board", but so that the corporate identity of the Board and its rights, powers, functions, duties, and liabilities shall not be affected.
- (2) A reference to the Western Australian Linseed Board, whether by use of that name or a similar or abbreviated form of that name—
 - (a) in any law of the State passed or made before the coming into operation of this section;
 - (b) in any document or other instrument made, executed, entered into, or done before the coming into operation of this section; and
 - (c) made before the coming into operation of this section in any other manner,

shall, unless the context is such that would be incorrect or inappropriate, be read and construed as a reference to the Western Australian Seed Board.

- (3) For the purposes of this section the term "law of the State" means—
 - (a) an Act;
 - (b) regulations, rules, or by-laws having effect by virtue of an Act: and
 - (c) an instrument having effect by virtue of an Act or of any regulations, rules or by-laws referred to in paragraph (b) of this subsection.
- 4. The principal Act is amended by adding after Addition of s. 3A. section 3 sections as follow—
 - 3A. (1) The Governor may by Order in Power of Governor Council published in the Government Gazette declare that any seed, in addition to linseed the purposes of this Act. and rapeseed to which this Act expressly applies. specified in the Order in Council is seed for the purposes of this Act.

- (2) In order to determine whether a proposal that a seed be declared a seed for the purposes of this Act is favoured by the producers of the seed concerned the Minister may arrange a ballot of those producers to be held at such time and in such manner as the regulations prescribe.
- (3) Where a ballot of producers held under this section results in a majority of votes against the proposal the seed shall not be declared a seed for the purposes of this Act.
- (1) The Governor may on the advice of the Board by Order in Council published in the Government Gazette declare that any seed grown or to be grown for local refining or processing in Western Australia may be exempted on a year to year basis from the provisions of this Act provided that such seed is the subject of a contract with a local processor.

(2) A local processor for the purpose of this section shall be a person whose sole or principal refining or processing works is situated in Western Australia.

Amendment to s. 5. (Interpretation.)

- 5. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by adding before the word "means" in line one of the interpretation "appointed date" the words "in relation to a seed":
 - (b) by substituting for the word "linseed", in line four of the interpretation "appointed date", the words "that seed":
 - (c) by adding after the interpretation "producer" an interpretation as follows—
 - "rapeseed" means the seed of the plant Brassica napus Linn. var. oleifera or the plant Brassica campestris Linn. var. oleifera or the seed of both those plants and includes any sample or parcel of seed containing not less than sixty per cent. of rapeseed;; and
 - (d) by adding after the interpretation "season" an interpretation as follows—
 - "seed" means linseed, rapeseed, and any other seed declared pursuant to section 3A of this Act to be a seed for the purposes of this Act; .

Amendment to s. 19. (Appointed date for the commencement of the marketing of linseed by the Board.) 6. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "linseed", in line two of subsection (1), the words "a seed".

Amendment to s. 25. (Sale of linseed by Board.)

- 7. Subsection (4) of section 25 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by substituting for paragraph (d) a paragraph as follows—
 - (d) shall pay into the fund established under section 25A of this Act such an amount per bushel of seed sold

as is determined from time to time by the Board but not exceeding onehalf of one cent per bushel; ;

- (b) by substituting for the word "pound", in line four of paragraph (e), the word "bushel"; and
- (c) by substituting for the words "a person entitled to compensation directs in writing", in lines five, six, and seven of paragraph (e), the words, "the Board thinks fit".
- 8. The principal Act is amended by adding after of s. 25A. section 25 a section as follows—
 - 25A. (1) The Board shall establish a fund Research to be known as the Seed Research Fund which shall be applied in seed research.
 - (2) There shall be a committee to be known as the Seed Research Committee to advise the Minister on the application of the Seed Research Fund.
 - (3) The Seed Research Committee—
 - (a) shall consist of three producers, one representative of the Department of Agriculture of the State, and one representative of the University of Western Australia all of whom shall be appointed by the Minister on such terms and conditions as he thinks fit: and
 - (b) may function notwithstanding any vacancy on it.
 - (4) Any person appointed to the Seed Research Committee may be removed by the Minister at any time.
 - (5) The Board shall pay from the Seed Research Fund for the purposes thereof such sums as are approved by the Minister on the recommendation of the Seed Research Committee.

Miscellaneous amendments.

9. The principal Act is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act.
