## COAL MINE WORKERS (PENSIONS) (No.2).

## AN ACT to amend the Coal Mine Workers (Pensions) Act, 1943-1970.

[Assented to 23rd September, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Coal Mine Workers (Pensions) Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.
- (2) In this Act the Coal Mine Workers (Pensions) Act. 1943-1970 is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Coal Mine Workers (Pensions) Act, 1943-1970.

Reprinted in Vol. 17 of the Reprinted Acts and amended by Acts Nos. 99 of 1964, 16 of 1965, 32 of 1965, 36 of 1965, and 5 of 1970. Amendment to s. 7. (Pension permanent incapacity.) 2. Subsection (2) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "he", in line eight, the words "or any one of his dependants".

Amendment to s. 10A. (Earnings from from employment.)

3. Subsection (3) of section 10A of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "pension", being the last word in the subsection, the passage ", other than an invalid pension as being a person who is permanently blind".

Amendment to s. 13. (Deductions from pensions.)

- 4. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by adding after subsection (1) a subsection as follows—
  - (1a) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply where the mine worker or any one of his dependants is, under the Social Services Act, 1947-1969 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth or any Act amending or in substitution for that Act, qualified to receive an invalid pension as being a person who is permanently blind.
